

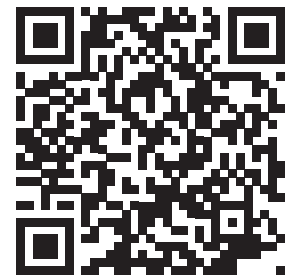


Save our Snake-necked Turtles

Our wetlands are home to a near threatened species of snake-necked turtle. In spring and summer (peaking September-November) these turtles travel away from the wetlands to search for a nesting site. During this journey, they are vulnerable to vehicle strike and predation.

You can help our turtles!

- Drive slowly around wetlands
- Ensure dogs are on leashes
- Wave off ravens impacting turtles
- If in danger, support them in the direction they were heading
- Record your turtle sightings using TurtleSAT
- Inform a turtle tracker if one onsite.
