Gate Entry Fees

Effective 1 July 2025

The following fees include the Landfill Levy, which the City is required to collect for the Department of Environment on each tonne of waste plus 10% GST.

Transfer station entry fees

Type of waste and vehicle	Per vehicle inc. 10% GST
Per Car (Sedan) boot not exceeding 1m ³	\$61
Van, Utility or Trailer up to but not exceeding 1m ³	\$89
Van, Utility or Trailer up to but not exceeding 1m ³ 1-2.5m ³	\$150
Van, Utility or Trailer exceeding 2.5m ³ but less than 3m ³	\$189
Per each inc. 10% GST	
Mattress Innerspring (Max of four per driver/load)	\$53
Tyre - Car off or on rims (Max four per driver/load)	\$11
4WD Tyre	\$22

Notes:

- Mixed Waste and Green Waste are charged at the same rate
- Loads more than three cubic metres and loads carried by heavy vehicles are deemed commercial and must enter the site via the weighbridge at 920 Rockingham Road
- All recyclable items and general waste must be separated prior to arriving on site. Failure to comply may result in the load being rejected or subject to additional fees
- Each load will be assessed by the gatehouse attendant whose decision shall be final.

Trailer passes

Cockburn property owners receive six trailer passes with their annual rates notices.

Trailer passes can be used for standard entry into the Henderson Waste Recovery Park and for green waste disposal. They also allow for green waste disposal only at the Regional Resource Recovery Centre in Canningvale.

Please present your trailer pass at the gate. Vouchers must be intact or may be scanned directly from a mobile device.

If you rent a property, contact your landlord or agent to request a trailer pass.

If you do not have a trailer pass, you will need to pay the entry fee.

You cannot sell or transfer your trailer passes.

Please note there is an additional charge for the disposal of innerspring mattresses, tyres and class II and III waste.

| ☐ | Paint (maximum of 100 litres) |
| ☐ | Hazardous household waste (maximum of 20 litres per day) |

Items must be separated from general waste in the load before entering site otherwise fees may apply.
