In accordance with the **City of Cockburn Health and Nuisances Local Law 2026** and the [Dust Management for Development Sites Policy](#), all earthworks carried out on a development site must be undertaken in compliance with a **Dust Management Plan (DMP)** that has been approved by the City.

The DMP must be prepared in accordance with the City's [Guidelines for the Preparation of Dust Management Plans](#) and the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation guideline document, [Land Development Sites and Impacts on Air Quality: A Guideline for the Prevention of Dust and Smoke Pollution from Land Development Sites in Western Australia](#) (25 July 1996).

The Dust Management Plan must include the following key documents:

- **Project and site information:** Provide contractor details, site plans showing proposed works, haul roads and nearby houses, a description of the earthworks, staging, timing, topsoil handling, duration, and the completed site classification assessment chart demonstrating the site's dust risk level.
- **Management, implementation and communication:** Outline dust control measures, green waste handling, stabilisation methods and progression for completed areas, how requirements will be included in construction contracts and specifications, and how surrounding residents will be notified about potential dust disturbances.
