On several occasions I have mentioned that Noel Morrison is well known to our family. Noel worked on my wife Patricia's parent's farm at Carnamah as a young man. We hadn't seen Noel for many years until one day we were walking along Coogee Beach and we recognised him sitting just in front of the sand dunes with his wife. He was making billy tea having gathered some dry sticks from the beach area to make a fire.

We sat and enjoyed the billy tea and catching up with what each of us had been doing in the intervening years. Amazingly, we recently unearthed some of Noel's paintings that he had given to Patricia's parents when he had worked on the farm. As Cassandra Cooper said earlier, Noel is not only a highly valued Noongar Elder in our community he is one of five indigenous artists exhibiting at Show Off 8 this year.

Patricia and I have previously purchased one of Noel's paintings and it is proudly displayed in our home.

Thank you Noel, it's always pleasing to see you at these exhibitions and to see your latest work.

'I acknowledge the Noongar people who are the Traditional Custodians of the Land on which we are meeting tonight.'

'I respect to the Elders both past and present of the Noongar Nation and extend that respect to other Indigenous Australians who may be present'.
