WiFi service expands again in the City of Cockburn

Free WiFi has expanded for the second time this year in the City of Cockburn.

The City has made WiFi freely available at Coogee Beach Reserve and Coolbellup Skate Park.

In June it was expanded to include Bibra Lake Regional Playground and has been available at Cockburn ARC since it opened to the public in May.

It has been a popular feature at Spearwood Library since 2011 and at Cockburn's other libraries and Cockburn Youth Centre for about four years.

At the youth centre, around 90 per cent of its young visitors use the WiFi service, with its use more than doubling in the last financial year from 5,969 users in 2015/16 to 13,252 users in 2016/17.

WiFi accessibility at the seniors centre has made it possible for participants in programs like iPad user groups and computer courses to gain skills to stay in touch via the world of digital communications.
