

## Clean Ocean Cuppas Competition

### Terms and Conditions

#### Resident Competition

Enter by collecting a clean ocean kit from a participating café and exchanging a bucket full of litter collected from the beach or surrounds for a free drink. Collect a loyalty card from a participating cafe and have it stamped by the café every time you collect a free drink. When 6 stamps are collected, complete your details on the reverse of the loyalty card and drop it back to any participating café before 1 March 2020.

- This competition is open to City of Cockburn residents and ratepayers only. Close family (spouse/partner, parents, children and grandchildren) of staff and Elected Members are not eligible to participate in the competition.
- Loyalty cards submitted will be collected from cafes by the City and placed in a container. The winner will be chosen at random by the City's Waste Education Coordinator and witnessed by the City's Waste Manager. No negotiation will be entered into once the winner has been chosen.
- The winner will be announced via public posts on social media. Winners will be contacted via email or telephone.
- The chosen winner will be required to provide proof of address within the City of Cockburn before claiming the prize.
- If the City is not able to contact the chosen winner within one week of contact, the prize will be re-drawn and another winner contacted.
- The prize will be a \$100 voucher to the participating café of the winner's choice.
- The winner may be contacted for a photograph to be included in the City's Soundings publication and/or local newspaper.

#### Café Competition

Cafes participating in the Clean Ocean Cuppas program 1 December 2019 to 1 March 2020 are eligible for the cafes competition. The café that gives away the highest number of free drinks in exchange for a full bucket of litter will be provided with a ¼ page advert in the Cockburn Gazette, paid for by the City of Cockburn, and a Facebook post from the City of Cockburn. The City can also design and place the advertisement on the café's behalf, if required.

In the event of two or more cafes having the joint highest number of drinks distributed, the City's Waste Education Coordinator will draw a winner at random.
