



## Rehabilitating Roe 8

### Advisory Committee Expression of Interest

#### Rehabilitating Roe 8

After the most recent State election the current Labour government declared the proposed Roe 8 Highway would not proceed.

This left a large tract of road reserve within the City of Cockburn from Bibra Drive west to Stock Rd in a semi cleared state. In acknowledgement of the natural flora and fauna values of this site the State government developed a working group that would oversee the development of a 10 year Rehabilitation Plan.

That plan is now complete and can be viewed on the City's website

One of the key outcomes of the rehabilitation plan is to have an advisory committee who will help implement the ten year rehabilitation plan.

#### The Advisory Committee

The Rehabilitating Roe 8 Advisory Committee is identified to represent the community engagement group or forum that will oversee the implementation of the Rehabilitating Roe 8 Management Plan (Emerge 2018). The advisory committee's primary role is to share information, exchange advice on management issues and help with the implementation of the Rehabilitating Roe 8 Management Plan.

The Rehabilitating Roe 8 Advisory Committee objectives are to:

- Provide advice on issues referred to the committee by the Project Manager
- Advise on the preparation and implementation of the Rehabilitating Roe 8 Management Plan and future revisions.
- Provide advice on matters of public concern or interest relating to the corridor.
- Assist the City in the dissemination of approved information to the broader community including science communications.
- Provide liaison and assist with coordinating community input into the corridor.



## Who can a committee member be?

Two general positions are available for this committee. These positions are open to individuals, community groups or others who are not part of the stakeholders identified in the Rehabilitation Management Plan development. Those stakeholders will receive direct invitation to nominate a representative.

Other members likely to be members of this committee include:

- Cockburn Community Wildlife Corridor (CCWC)
- Perth Urban Restoration Scientific Advisory Committee (PURSAC)
- South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council (SWALSC)
- Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA)

It is anticipated the committee will have a maximum membership of 15 committee members with voting rights. The City of Cockburn will administer the meetings and be responsible for setting agendas, meeting dates, venue and distribution of minutes etc.

The committee member cannot represent any commercial interests that may be seen to create a conflict of interest. It is expected that this person will have some knowledge, interest or experience of natural resource management or conservation and be willing to act as a representative for the advisory committee at events etc.

On appointment the Terms of Reference for the committee will be supplied along with a copy of the City of Cockburn Reference Group Protocols.

## Meeting Schedules

Meetings will occur every month, most likely an afternoon on a Tuesday, for 2 hours with the date and meeting venue to be confirmed.

The inaugural meeting of the advisory committee will be coming up in early November.

Once submissions have been received they will be reviewed by the City and the successful candidate notified. Once all committee membership positions have been confirmed the Rehabilitating Roe 8 Project Manager will confirm meeting date, agendas etc by email.
