



## Recommendations (June 2019)

The objectives of the My Best Home project is to document and publish our findings in such a way that will promote the housing needs of residents 50+ and promote the design of homes that our residents want to live in.

Therefore we will:

1. Prepare a **DIY handbook** to make it easier for home owners/residents 50+ to consider housing options to age in place in their suburb. The handbook will be in a digital easy to download format available on the My Best Home webpage. See link below in the coming weeks.
2. Collate a **Community Engagement Outcomes Report** consolidating the 3 stages of our research - how we did it and who was involved. This report also identifies groups workshop design outcomes and can be downloaded on our webpage now.
3. Provide key stakeholders with **Information for designing the best homes for Cockburn's residents 50+**. This report is for residents and landowners when considering right sizing options. Importantly builders, designers and real estate agents will also find this information highly relevant to consider when designing new homes or modifying existing ones for residents 50+ in Cockburn.
4. Feedback received by participants expressed a clear desire for a demonstration home. While this may be difficult for the City to undertake, due to costs, we will continue exploring options and promoting this idea to developers and other relevant stakeholders. Watch this space!
