Background:

The Health Act 1911 provides for the Council to deputise its functions under Parts IV, V, VI, VII, and IX to a nominated Council Officer.

Purpose:

To provide a consistent approach to the exercise of the Council's discretion under the Acts.

Policy:

In respect to Parts IV, V, VI, VII, and IX of the Health Act 1911, the Council will deputise the Manager, Environmental Health and Co-ordinator Environmental Health to act on its behalf. The authorisation to initiate legal action for breaches of the Health Act 1911 and associated Health legislation on behalf of the City is limited to the Manager, Environmental Health only (or the person Acting in this role).
