How to Enter

Enter by posting a photograph or video of yourself and/or your household members on Facebook, using the hashtag #CockburnBinOuting. The photograph should showcase your best fancy dress look – the more creative, the better. Make sure your post is publicly viewable to ensure that it is entered into the competition. Submissions will only be accepted until 30 April 2020.
