

How secure is your home and property?

Find out by completing our Home Security Checklist. The more boxes you tick, the more secure your home and property.

Home

- Does your door have a peephole?
- Does your house have an automatic light timer or sensor lights?
- Are the entrances to your home well lit?
- Are your contents and valuables engraved or marked for easy identification?
- Have you recorded the serial numbers of your contents and valuables?
- Have you saved emergency numbers in your phone?
- Have you joined Neighbourhood Watch?

Locks and security

- Do you have locks and deadbolts, or deadlocks fitted on your doors?
- Do you have security screens on doors and windows?
- Do your windows have key-locks or security devices?
- Does your home have external Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV)?
- Is your home fitted with an alarm?
- Is the meter box locked?



Garden, sheds, and surrounds

- Are your trees and shrubs trimmed so it's hard for burglars to hide behind?
- Are there fences and gates on your property to restrict access?
- Is the garage or shed kept locked?
- Are your tools and ladders stored away?
- Is your house number clearly visible from the street?
- Do you have a dog?

Going on holidays?

- Have you arranged for mail to be held or redirected by your post office, or have you asked a neighbour to collect your mail?
- Have you asked a neighbour to take out and bring in your rubbish and recycling bins on the allocated bin days?
- Are your house keys left with a friend or neighbour instead of hidden inside or outside the house?
- Have you left an inside light on with a timer?
