

What's being done about traffic in Cockburn?

Don't worry something's being done all levels of government are working together to reduce the traffic congestion at Cockburn Central around Kwinana freeway at Berrigan Drive and along our major connecting roads running east-west and north-south across the city. Yeah, they're working on it I told ya! To improve traffic flow at Cockburn Central part of Armadale Road has been widened at Cockburn Central Train Station a larger car park east of the station has opened. The realignment of Knock has also provided another way of accessing the car park and allows commuters quicker entry and exit out of the train station and a new bridge has been built over Kwinana freeway to connect North Lake Road to Armadale Road. Not bad huh! Yeah not bad! To reduce congestion getting on and off the freeway at Berrigan Drive they've widened Kwinana freeway from Russell to Farrington Road widened parts of Karol Avenue and are doing the same along Jandakot Road from Solomon Road to Berrigan Drive. I told you, I told you! To improve the journey along our major east-west north-south connector roads the Stock Road and Beeliar Drive intersection has been upgraded and Spearwood Avenue widened.
