

Sports Equipment Grant Overview

Sport and Recreation plays an important role in keeping our local community vibrant and active. The City of Cockburn is proud to have a number of local sporting clubs that provide a variety of sporting opportunities to the wider community.

To assist our local clubs, the Sports Equipment Grant (SEG) has been developed by Council to further reflect our commitment to support local sporting clubs by contributing to the purchase of essential sports equipment.

The key focus of the SEG is to aid in upgrading sporting equipment with the aim to increase community participation in sport and recreation. The maximum grant available through the SEG is **\$1,000** per year with Council’s contribution not to exceed 50% of the total cost.

Criteria

What are the eligibility criteria?

- The SEG will only be available to incorporated and not for profit sport or recreation clubs.
- Clubs must be based or operating within the City of Cockburn.
- Clubs must be servicing a significant number of local residents.

What else?

- No additional funding will be provided over the approved application.
- Grants will not exceed 50% of the total project cost.
- Additional information must be attached to the application form i.e. quote or itemised invoice.
- Funds are required to be used for “club owned” equipment for a team purpose.
- Funds are not to be used for equipment for an individual purpose i.e. boots, mouthguards.
- No retrospective funding will be provided for goods already purchased.

Process
