Terms and Conditions

How to Enter

Enter by posting a photograph or video of yourself on Facebook or Instagram with three pieces of litter, using the hashtag #take3fortheseacockburn. Make sure your post is publicly viewable to ensure that it is entered into the competition. Submissions will only be accepted between 1 December 2019 and 9 March 2020.

- This competition is open to City of Cockburn residents and ratepayers only. Close family (spouse/partner, parents, children and grandchildren) of staff and Elected Members are not eligible to participate in the competition.
- Profile names of all entrants will be printed and placed in a container. The winner will be chosen at random by the City's Waste Education Coordinator and witnessed by the City's Waste Manager. No negotiation will be entered into once the winner has been chosen.
- The winner will be announced via public posts on social media. Winners will also be contacted via private message on the social media site they used to submit their entry.
- The chosen winner will be required to provide proof of address within the City of Cockburn before claiming the prize.
- If the City does not receive a response from the winner within one week of contact, the prize will be re-drawn and another winner contacted.
- The prize will be a trip to Rottnest for 4 people, including return ferry tickets and accommodation for 2 nights.
- The City reserves the right to share, print and distribute the images/videos posted as competition entries, to further promote the Take 3 for the Sea campaign.
- The winner may be contacted for a photograph to be included in the City's Soundings publication and/or local newspaper.
