TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Age Groups 5–10 years of age, 11–17 years of age and 18+.
- Depending on application numbers, performances will be split according to age.
- City of Cockburn residents only are permitted to enter this competition.
- Any performance type is allowed, however it must be tasteful with no profanities. If the performance involves high level of risk, indemnification must be provided.
- Maximum five (5) minutes performance duration, if accompanied by a song selection this must be submitted at least four (4) days prior to the performance date. This must be provided to the City of Cockburn via email or on CD in MP3 format ONLY.
- Performers must sign in 20 minutes prior to their performance on their allocated night.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. All prizes are non-transferable and are subject to the rules of the competition.
- Performers will be allocated a performance spot on a first come first served basis, as long as all other criteria are adhered to.
- City of Cockburn staff and direct family of staff and/or Elected Members are not eligible to enter.
- Performers will be able to change their performance date (where available), in circumstances of illness, injury or emergency.
- All photographs and video taken during the competition will remain the property of the City of Cockburn and may be used in future City of Cockburn advertising and promotions.
- You will be judged on the following categories with a maximum of 50 points available to each entrant:
 - Uniqueness (10 points)
 - Overall ability and talent (10 points)
 - Audience appeal (10 points)
 - Presentation (10 points)
 - Potential (10 points)
