## NOTICE OF PUBLIC CENSURE

The Local Government Standards Panel has found that Deputy Mayor Lee-Anne Smith, a Councillor of the City of Cockburn, twice breached regulation 7(1)(b) of the Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2007 (WA) when on 24 August when at the Special Meeting of Council held 22 August 2018 she:

- falsely stated that Councillor Chontelle Sands was the subject of two minor breach complaints and an investigation by the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries: and
- b. stated that Councillor Chontelle Sands had lied about an having an impartiality interest in respect to a matter previously considered by the Council.

In engaging in this conduct, Deputy Mayor Lee-Anne Smith made improper use of her office as a council member with the intent to cause detriment to Councillor Sands. The Panel censures Councillor Smith for the two breaches of regulation 7(1)(b) of the Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2008 (WA).
